

## Cross Plains Baseball

### Code of Conduct – Players and Parents

All players and coaches will be dressed and ready to take the field at the time assigned to them. (People will be late at times; if you anticipate being late for any reason please call to let the coach know). Excessive lateness will be dealt within a reasonable matter.

All players should be fully dressed while approaching the field. No earrings, bracelets, or any kind of jewelry will be allowed.

Dugout: Food, Cell Phones, I-Pod, and other items deemed a distraction are not allowed around or in the dugout. Equipment will not be thrown, broken, or punched (if a player breaks team equipment they will have to pay for the item). Inappropriate language will not be tolerated in the dugout or on the field at any time before, during or after the game. Family and Friends are not allowed to engage in long conversations with any player or coach before or during the game. NO EXCEPTIONS.

If a player, friend, or family member has a comment, gesture, or physically does something that is deemed inappropriate to a fellow player, coach, opposing player, opposing coach, or umpire; the player and family will be asked to leave the field complex, immediately. If a player and or family member is insubordinate after being asked to leave they will be removed from the team and organization.

Players will be the only person that the coach will address if a player has a problem with a decision concerning a player on the field.

Off Field: Any action that occurs off the field that is deemed inexcusable and compromises the image of Cross Plains Baseball Organization while a player may result in removal of the player from the organization.
